

NOTICE OF A FLOODPLAIN DEVELOPMENT PERMIT REQUEST

The City of Deer Lodge received a request for a Floodplain Development Permit from Great West Engineering, Inc., of P.O. Box 4817, 2501 Belt View Drive, Helena, MT 59604. Great West Engineering is acting on the behalf of the Montana Department of Transportation. The requested Permit is to facilitate the replacement of the existing structure and construction of a new Conley Avenue Bridge to span the Clark Fork River. The proposed bridge will incorporate a design having a greater hydraulic capacity resulting in a 0.22-foot decrease in the 100-year water surface elevation compared to the existing bridge. A Floodplain Development Permit is necessary as the project site lies in the Regulatory Floodway of the Clark Fork River as shown on Flood Insurance Rate Map Panel #30060 0001 B. The project site is west Main Street in Section 4, Township 7 North, Range 9 West.
