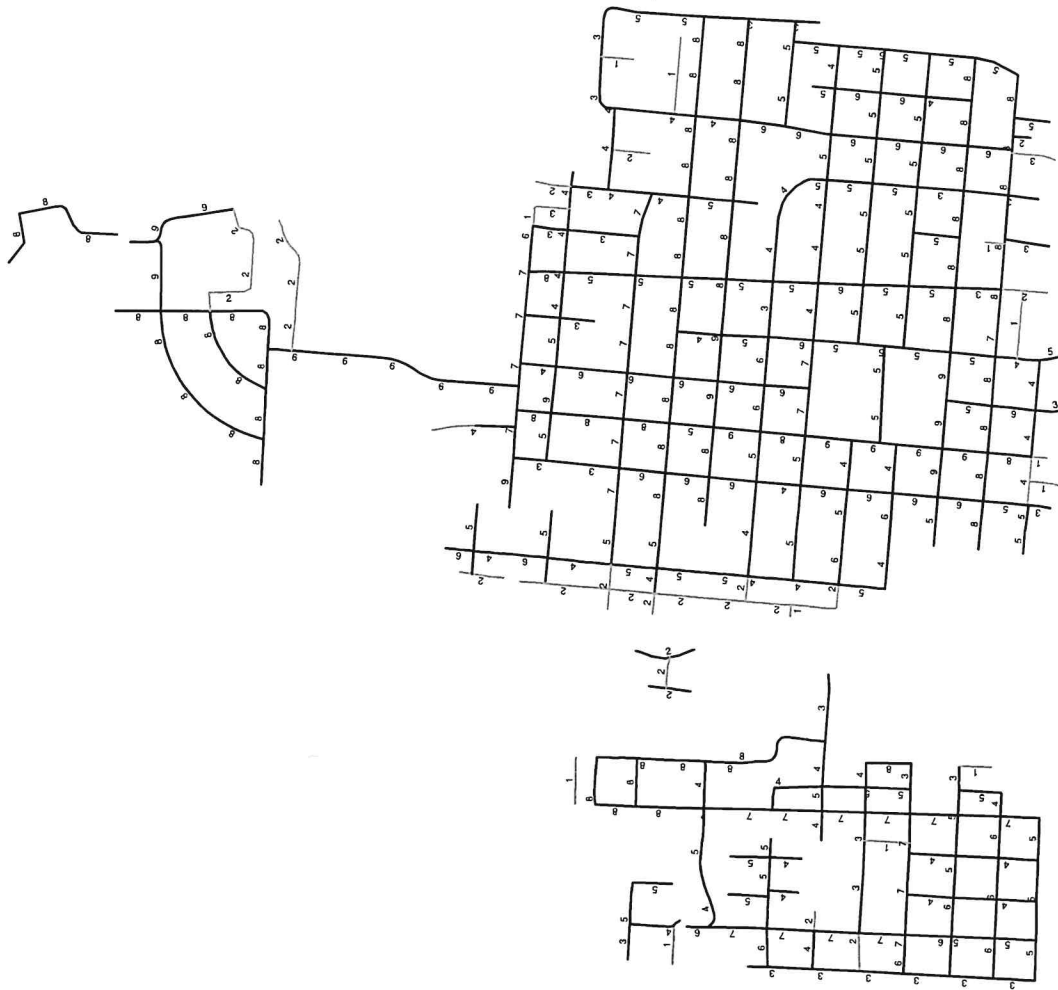
DEER LODGE PASER - 2022 THROUGH 2029
