# 1. Call Meeting to Order:

Member Kersch motioned to approve as presented. Chairman Pierson seconded the motion. 2 Ayes, 0 Nos, 1 Vacant. Motion passed.

# New Business:

 Stahly Engineering Task Order for MCEP/RRG Grant Writing and Administration for Wastewater Collection System Improvements – Jordan

This scope of work will review the existing PER for the City's Wastewater System to identify the scope of a Phase 2 Inflow and Infiltration reduction project. It also includes grant writing to the MCEP and RRGL programs to fund the project. Amount of the grant asks will be discussed at the next Finance and City Council meeting. Total task order cost for grant prep is \$16,500. Grant amounts: MCEP - \$375,000, RRG - \$125,000, Match - \$250,000 (with 50% SRF loan forgiveness). On April 23, 2024, the Public Works Committee recommended the approval of this task order to the Finance Committee and City Council.

Chairman Pierson motioned to approve as presented with recommendation to City Council. Member Kersch seconded the motion. 2 Ayes, 0 Nos, 1 Vacant. Motion passed.

# b. Montana League of Cities and Towns Financial Assistance Contract - Jordan

The Montana League of Cities and Towns recently hired Jodi Rogers, lifelong clerk/treasurer from Choteau, to help local communities with financial services. We would like to contract for her assistance and to help train Stan on the following: long-range budget forecasting, budget transfers, GAAP/GASB principles, and other high-level municipal financing topics.

Member Kersh motioned to approve as presented with recommendation to City Council. Chairman Pierson seconded the motion. 2 Ayes, 0 Nos, 1 Vacant. Motion passed.

# c. Deer Lodge Little League Contract - Jordan

For the past three years, the City has had a contract with the Little League where the City gave field use authorization to the League and paid \$1,000/year to the League to maintain one field. The League approached Parks and Rec Committee to renegotiate the contract. The proposed contract would still give access to the fields, but up the amount to \$8,000/year for 3 years. The intent is for them to improve one field a year in addition to maintenance on previously improved fields. At its March meeting, the Parks and Recreation committee discussed the proposal from the League and at its April meeting, it was recommended the draft contract language to the Finance Committee and City Council for approval.

Member Kersch motioned a recommendation to City Council with amended contract language "up to \$8,000/year for 3 years and the Recreation Department to provide yearly quotes of maintenance and supplies". Chairman Pierson seconded the motion. 2 Ayes, 0 Nos, 1 Vacant. Motion passed.

# d. Supplemental Funding for Chamber of Commerce Yearly Deer Lodge App Invoice - Jordan

When the Deer Lodge app was implemented by the County, the Chamber agreed to fundraise for the yearly \$5,000 invoice. However, the invoice came 3 months earlier than expected and the Chamber had not fundraised enough yet. The Chamber had raised \$1,450. In order to keep the app functioning, I propose we supplement this yearly payment with the consideration that the Chamber continue to fundraise this year to help offset our costs and become self-sustaining next year. Recommend approval of the supplemental funding of \$3,550 to the City Council.

Member Kersch motioned and recommended to City Council to approve the \$3,550 as a One-Time loan with a due date of September 2024 from the Chamber of Commerce. Chairman Pierson seconded the motion. 2 Ayes, 0 Nos, 1 Vacant. Motion passed.

# e. Pay Application #1 for Wastewater Improvements Project - Trent

Pay Application #1 with associated Change Orders submitted by MJD Contracting for the Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Project in the amount of \$404,772.39. Installation of sewer manhole in two locations on Montana Ave. This is required to gain access to ends of the lines for slip lining. Public Works Committee recommended the Pay Application at their 4/23/2024 meeting.

Member Kersch motioned and recommended to City Council to approve Pay Application #1 for Wastewater Improvements Project. Chairman Pierson seconded the motion. 2 Ayes, 0 Nos, 1 Vacant. Motion passed.

f. 2024 Street Maintenance Project Recommendation to Award - Trent

Recommendation of Award to Helena Sand and Gravel for the 2024 Street Maintenance Project, which consists of Rainbow Avenue Reconstruct and Mill and Over on Pennsylvania Ave., Park St., and Pavilion Lane in the amount of \$469,512.00. Also requested is a 10% contingency to expedite any potential change orders. Total amount requested is \$516,463.20. Public Works recommended the award and contingency at their April 23, 2024 meeting.

Chairman Pierson motioned to approve as presented with recommendation to City Council. Member Kersch seconded the motion. 2 Ayes, 0 Nos, 1 Vacant. Motion passed.

ATIIP stands for Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program. The Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program (ATIIP) is a new competitive grant program created by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. It aims to construct safe and connected active transportation facilities, including bike paths and walking trails, within communities and between communities. The project that I'm proposing that we put forward to funding is a planning and 100% design of a freeway to freeway, Main Street improvement. That includes everything from trails and walkability to safety features to stormwater features to street trees, benches, sidewalk improvements, curb both outs, pretty much everything that makes the street both safe, walkable and an interesting place to be. City will work with Stahly Engineers daily, their Extension and their subcontract landscaping architecture firm. MDT has agreed to be on board throughout the whole planning process to make sure that everything that we do will not inhibit their ability to maintain industry.

#### TITLE 1: GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Fees, Licenses, or Permits: None
- Fines/Penalty: Title 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS: Chapter 1.08: GENERAL PENALTY contains the basis for all Fines that are not specifically identify in the City Code of Deer Lodge.

#### 1.08.010: GENERAL PENALTY

- A. Whenever in any provision of this Code or other ordinance of the City any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful, a misdemeanor or an offense, or whenever in any such provision or ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, where no specific penalty is otherwise provided therefor, any person upon conviction for the violation of any such provision of this Code or ordinances shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the first or second like violation or in the event of a third or subsequent like violation by imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment, for each such offense.
- Each day any violation of any ordinance shall continue, shall constitute a separate offense.
  - a. Provisions for first, second, third, or subsequent violations described in A. above do not apply in the event of a continuation of offense as described in A.1. above.
- B. In the construction and interpretation of this section, the revocation of a license or permit shall not be considered as a recovery or penalty so as to bar any other penalty being enforced.

(Ordinance 1 - 1/17/1980: Effective 1/17/1980)

#### 1.08.020: EXECUTION OF A FINE.

- If the judgment is for a fine alone, execution may issue thereon as on a judgment in a civil case.
- B. A judgment that the defendant pay a fine may also direct that he be imprisoned until the fine be satisfied, in the proportion of one day's imprisonment for every ten dollars (\$10.00) of the fine.

#### RESOLUTION 2024-R-14

# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE MONTANA BOARD OF INVESTMENTS OF SHORT-TERM INVESTMENT POOL AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF DOCUMENTS RELATED THERETO

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER LODGE AS FOLLOWS:

#### ARTICLE I

#### DEFINITIONS

The following terms will have the meanings indicated below for all purposes of this Resolution unless the context clearly requires otherwise:

- "Account" means a specific Participant Bank account to be used in conducting STIP Program transactions.
- "Agreement" means the agreements of the Participant contained within this Resolution.
- "Authorized Representative" means the officer or official of the Participant designated and authorized by the Governing Body to act on behalf of Participant in the STIP Program.
- "Authorized Delegate" means any officer, official, or employee of the Participant delegated authority by the Authorized Representative to initiate transactions using the STIP Program.
- "Bank" means a financial institution designated and authorized to send and receive money on behalf of the Participant for purposes of participation in the STIP Program.
- "Board" means the Board of Investments, a state agency organized and existing under the laws of the State.
- "Exhibit A" means the STIP Participation Information Sheet attached to and incorporated into this Resolution as provided in Article IV, Section 3.01.
- "Exhibit B" means the Electronic Funds Transfer Authorization Form attached to and incorporated into this Resolution as provided in Article IV, Section 3.01.
- "Governing Body" means the governing body of political subdivision (Participant) authorized by Montana state law to participate in the STIP Program.
- "Participant" means the political subdivision requesting participation in the Board's STIP Program.
- "Short-Term Investment Pool" means the Board's investment program administered under the direction of the Board of Investments as authorized by the Unified Investment Program and as more fully defined and described by

the Montana Code Annotated and in the Board's Governing Policies. "Short-Term Investment Pool" is synonymous with "STIP" and "Program" as used in this Resolution and Exhibits A and B.

# SHORT-TERM INVESTMENT POOL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

Section 1.01 <u>Participation Agreement</u>. The Governing Body requests participation in the STIP Program and agrees that Participant will comply with and be bound by all laws, policies, procedures, and participation requirements applicable to the Program, as may be amended from time to time.

Section 1.02 <u>STIP Program</u>. STIP is available to state and local governments to serve their short-term cash flow and deposit needs. The Program's objectives are to preserve capital and maintain high liquidity. The Program has the following attributes:

- 1) STIP transactions are fixed at \$1 per share;
- STIP interest on pool assets accrues daily;
- 3) STIP earnings distribution methods are: (a) Interest is distributed at the beginning of the month and can be distributed as cash to the designated Bank; or (b) earnings can be reinvested into STIP;
- 4) Buying or selling shares in STIP requires one (1) business day's notice (transactions for which notice is received after 2:00 p.m. will be processed two (2) business days after receipt of the original notice);
- 5) Access to STIP is only through the Board's electronic web-based portal (no cash, checks or notifications by fax, phone or email will be accepted);
- 6) The Board's STIP web portal provides real-time information on each account including investment balances, buys, sells, pending transactions, and transaction notes, as determined by the authorized user; and
- 7) The Board reports the Short-Term Investment Pool on a Net Asset Value (NAV) basis on its financial statements. A NAV per share of STIP will be reflected on the Board's website for each month-end period.

Section 1.03 Review of Policies, Procedures, and Participation Requirements. Participant represents that it has reviewed to its satisfaction all Board policies, procedures, and participation requirements applicable to the STIP Program. See, Board Governance Policies 40.600, 40.601, and 40.602.

Section 1.04 <u>Authorized Representative</u>: The Governing Body designates STANLEY GLOVAN, who holds the position of CITY TREASURER as the Participant's Authorized Representative to conduct transactions between STIP and the Bank.

The Governing Body DOES allow the Authorized Representative to appoint and remove additional Authorized Delegate(s) on behalf of the Participant. If "DOES" is checked, any addition or removal of an Authorized Delegate requires notice via the submission of a completed Exhibit A (STIP Participation Information Sheet) to the Board by the Authorized Representative before transactions will be accepted and processed.

The Governing Body designates and authorizes the Participant's Bank, (the "Bank"), identified in Exhibit B, with the Account Number and American Bankers Association (ABA) Number, for settlement of STIP participant transactions. The account is a CHECKING ACCOUNT.

The Governing Body DOES allow the Authorized Representative to change either the Bank or the Account. If 'DOES' is checked, the Board will notify both the office of the Authorized Representative AND the office of the Governing Body within three (3) business days that such a change has been made.

The Governing Body DOES allow the Authorized Representative to change the earnings distribution method.

Section 1.05 <u>Change of Authorized Representative</u>. Any change to the Authorized Representative requires a new Resolution adopted by the Governing Body. However, the absence of an Authorized Representative does not nullify the current authority of the Authorized Delegate(s) to make STIP transactions.

Section 1.06 <u>Annual Confirmation</u>. The Board will annually confirm with the Governing Body and the Authorized Representative the:

- 1. Name of the Authorized Representative;
- 2. Name(s) of any Authorized Delegate(s); and
- 3. Name of the Bank and the associated Account Numbers (truncated).

Section 1.07 <u>Effective Date</u>. Participant's Agreement will take effect when the Resolution Certificate, this Resolution, and completed and executed Exhibits A and B are received by the Board. The Participant's Agreement will stay in effect until terminated in writing by the Governing Body.

#### ARTICLE II

#### MISCELLANEOUS

- Section 2.01 <u>No Guaranteed Return</u>. The Governing Body understands and agrees that there is no minimum or maximum interest rate or any guaranteed rate of return on STIP shares or funds invested in STIP shares.
- Section 2.02 <u>Voluntary Participation</u>. By adopting this Resolution, the Governing Body acknowledges that it is not compelled to participate in STIP, that its participation in STIP is voluntary, and agrees to the Board's administration and governance of the Program according to the Board's policies, procedures, and participation requirements.
- Section 2.03 Responsibility for Participant Mistakes. The Governing Body and Participant agree to hold harmless the state of Montana, the Board, and the Board's members, officials, and employees for the acts, omissions, mistakes, and negligence of the Participant, Governing Body, and their members, officials, and employees, including but not limited to an Authorized Representative or Authorized Delegate who, for any reason, is not qualified or mistakenly listed

with the Board as a permissible representative to authorize transactions using the STIP Program, incorrect instructions as to amounts or timing of sales or purchases, or missed deadlines.

Section 2.04 No Warranty. The Governing Body and Participant agree that the Board makes no warranty that funds will be immediately available in the event of any failure of a third party or that Governing Body will not suffer losses due to acts of God, natural disasters, terrorism or threats of terrorism, civil disorder, medical epidemics or other calamities, or other market dislocations or interruptions.

Section 2.05 Participation Conditions; STIP Administration. The Governing Body and Participant acknowledge and agree that the Board will allow participation in STIP by and conduct STIP business with only those parties it determines are qualified and authorized to participate in the Program who abide by the Board's policies, procedures, and participation requirements. The Governing Body and Participant understand that the Board administers the STIP Program subject to Montana law and prudent fiduciary practices as required by Montana law and Board policy and that the Board is legally charged to manage the Unified Investment Program, which includes STIP, in accordance with the prudent expert rule as set forth in Montana law.

Section 2.06 <u>STIP Not Insured Against Loss</u>. The Governing Body and Participant understand and acknowledge that the Board's STIP Program is NOT FDIC insured or otherwise insured or guaranteed by the federal government, the state of Montana, the Board, or any other entity against investment losses.

#### ARTICLE III

#### EXHIBITS A AND B

Section 3.01 Approval and Adoption of Exhibits A and B. Attached to this Resolution are Exhibit A, the STIP Participation Information Sheet, and Exhibit B, the Electronic Funds Transfer Authorization Form, which together provide the instructions required by the Board to enable Participant's participation in the STIP Program. The Governing Body and Participant represent that Exhibits A and B have been completed and executed by the Participant's Authorized Representative and that Exhibits A and B must be complete and accepted by the Board before participation is allowed in the STIP Program. Exhibits A and B are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution and are approved and adopted by the Governing Body as if set forth fully herein.






